

## The global language of business







#### **GTIN**

#### Global Trade Item Number

The GS1 number for identifying products. Most commonly 13-digits long but can also be 8-digits for small items, 12-digits for US products, and 14-digits for cases and traded units.

#### EAN / UPC

European Article Number/ Universal product code

The standard barcode image that represents the 13-digit GTIN on most products you buy in shops in the UK and globally.

## What is efficient receive?

Efficient receive allows Amazon to scan your products and receive efficiently without having to open each box and scan every item

To enable efficient receive suppliers are required to provide carton level information either through:

#### **License Plate Receive**

- Serialised Shipment Container Code (SSCC) if passed via EDI
- 2. Or Amazon Carton Content (AMZNCC) if generated via Vendor Central

or

#### **GTIN Receive**

Sharing product data electronically, so Amazon know what's in the box just by scanning the GTIN barcode



## **Understanding the acronyms**

#### SSCC

Serialised Shipping Container Code

Used by companies to identify a logistical unit

#### **GDSN**

Global Data Synchronisation Network

The world's largest product data network governed by GS1 Standards.

#### **AMZNCC**

Amazon specific container code

Amazon's own shipping container codes - only work when sending inventory into Amazon.

#### **EDI**

Electronic Data Interchange


The exchange of standard business documents between two companies by computer.



## **Amazon efficient receive**

#### **Option 1: License plate receive**

Every carton must be labelled with an external container ID - either a Serial Shipping Container Code (SSCC) which can be passed via Electronic Data Interchange (EDI), or an Amazon Carton Content (AMZNCC) code if generated via Vendor Central (VC).





## **Amazon efficient receive**

#### **Option 2: GTIN receive**

If you have GTIN 13 or 14-digit identifiers on your cartons as standard, you can share GTINs (and other optional attributes) with Amazon via GDSN to efficiently receive products.









