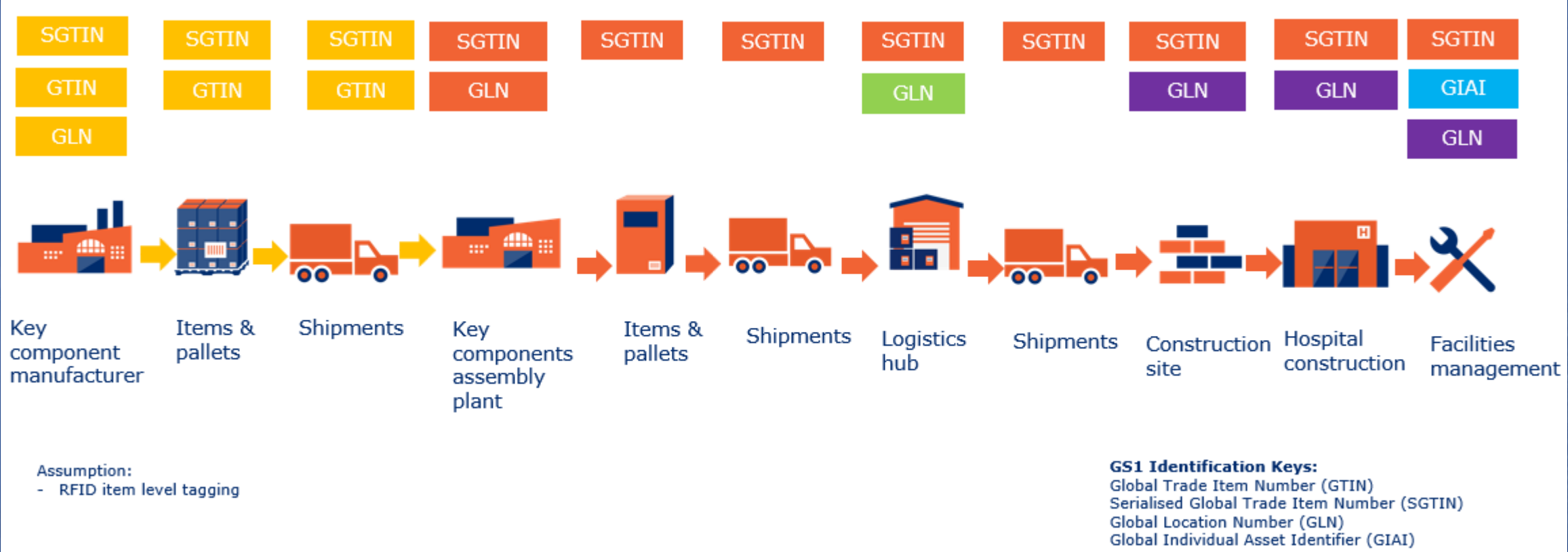

# GS1 and Construction

## Sustainability/Traceability:
