

Death rate as a % difference from the least deprived decile












Mode of GP appointment



GPs per 100,000 population






















Percent waiting >62 days from urgent GP referral to first treatment for cancer









Contributors to global sea sea level rise (1993-2018)







FIGURE 1: UK EXPENDITURE ON HEALTH









