New membership contract with GS1 UK Ltd

NHS Digital has agreed a new contract with GS1 UK Ltd, which runs from **1 April 2019 to 31 March 2024**.

This contract replaces the previous five-year agreement with GS1 UK, which expired at the end of **March 2019**.

The new contract:



Enables NHS organisations to continue to use GS1 barcodes for patient wristbands;

Provides greater clarity for the use of GS1 standards for new applications based on barcodes and other data carriers across the NHS;

For the first time highlights CIOs as the accountable people to manage GS1 standards in their organisation;

Includes access to the Global Location Number registry (LocationManager), a service which allows location information to be centrally accessed by trading partners;

Includes the ability to purchase additional consultancy services, if required, by individual organisations.
